The Academy of Hospitality & Tourism is a four year program designed to introduce high school students to the Hospitality & Tourism Industry. This program is funded by the New York City Department of Education in partnership with Hospitality & Tourism organizations throughout New York City. Presently the program, with over 1,000 students enrolled, is in place (from the 9th grade through the 12th grade level) at the following nine New York City High Schools:

1. Academy of Hospitality & Tourism High School at Erasmus (Brooklyn)
2. Grover Cleveland High School (Queens)
3. High School for Enterprise, Business & Technology (Brooklyn)
4. High School for Hospitality Management (Manhattan)
5. Jacqueline Kennedy Onassis High School for International Careers (Manhattan)
6. New Utrecht High School (Brooklyn)
7. Port Richmond High School (Staten Island)
8. Richmond Hill High School (Queens)
9. Susan Wagner High School (Staten Island)

The Academy of Hospitality & Tourism is looking to establish 2013 summer internships for its students (see attached information). These internships would be for a six to eight week period during the months of July 2013 and August 2013. The students should be paid at the prevailing minimum wage by your hotel. If you are interested in becoming involved with this highly worthwhile program, please fill out the attached form and return it at your earliest convenience. The Academy will then arrange for a student interview. All students are prescreened and have Microsoft Office skills. What is the internship?

- *A six-eight week summer position providing challenging opportunities and exposure to the business world.*
- *Paid at entry level wage; costs for 8 week internship range from \$2000-\$2500*
- *Students are prescreened for workplace readiness skills*
- *Students may be assigned to one department or rotated through several.*
- *We can accommodate part-time intern positions throughout the year.*

Our interns are prescreened by the Academy to insure they have resumes, Social Security cards, working papers etc. We interview each student and evaluate their "soft skills" and knowledge specific to the themes of Hospitality, Finance, Engineering or Information Technology.

Students qualify for an internship after completing at least 4 courses in the Academy Curriculum, and have attended work-readiness activities such as Job Shadowing, student conferences or workshops. All interns have Microsoft Office skills.

Academy of Finance courses include: Principles of Finance, Banking & Credit, Financial Planning, Financial Services, Economics and Accounting.

Academy of Hospitality & Tourism courses include: Hospitality & Tourism Systems, Geography, Principles of Hospitality & Tourism, Lodging Management and Strategies for Success. One of our schools also has a Culinary program.

Academy of Information Technology courses include: Principals of Information Technology, Web Design, Computer Systems, Digital Media and Computer Networking. Some Academies also offer Oracle and C++.

After that process is complete, we're ready to send resumes to our partners and set up interviews at the worksites.
