- 2. Small Properties (Less than 250 keys): Social Responsibility Award, Environmental Protection Award and Holistic Sustainability Strategy Award (Triple Bottom Line).

If you have not already applied for these awards we recommend that you do so and return the attached questionnaire via email to sustainablecommittee@hanyc.org by July 10, 2015.

A panel of experts will study the applications and visit hotels with the most engaging responses in order to review the programs and select the awardees.

Finalists will be announced in early November and winners will get their awards during the IH/M&RS. Please come and join us in celebrating the outstanding accomplishments of our member hotels.
