2. Small Properties (Less than 250 keys): Social Responsibility Award, Environmental Protection Award and Holistic Sustainability Strategy Award (Triple Bottom Line).

A panel of experts will study the applications and visit hotels with the most engaging responses in order to review the programs and select the awardees.
