Golf: Acceptable Attire:

Golf slacks, chinos, bermuda shorts, culottes, golf skirts, turtlenecks or collared shirts.

Unacceptable Attire:

No tee shirts, tennis attire, short shorts, tank tops, denim or jeans of any kind are permitted on the golf course, driving range or putting greens.

The policy of the Scarsdale Golf Club prohibits the usage of metal spikes on the golf course. Please have soft spikes installed on your golf shoes prior to the event if at all possible. The club will be available to install soft spikes on the day of the event at a nominal charge if necessary.

Acceptable Attire

Clothing in all white is encouraged but tasteful colored attire is allowed. Male players must wear a collared shirt. Regulation tennis shoes, appropriate for soft courts, are mandatory.

Unacceptable Attire

Tee shirts, cut offs, bermuda or golf shorts, jogging, gym or basketball shorts, tank tops, leggings, leotards and bathing suits, cross trainers, jogging shoes, runner's shoes, basketball shoes and shoes with high heels or gradient soles may not be worn.

Anyone not observing the dress code will not be allowed on the Tennis Courts.

Manhattan

1. Take Major Deegan North (also called New York Thruway or Route 87) to Exit 4 (Cross County Parkway) in Westchester (Do not take Exit 4 (161st Street/Yankee Stadium) in Manhattan).
2. After exiting, you will need to get to the extreme right very quickly. As you enter the approach ramp to the Cross County Parkway East, be sure to keep to your right. Do not follow the sign for Hutchinson Parkway. Bear right onto Cross County Parkway East (follow signs for Bronx Parkway North) to Exit 6 (Bronx Parkway North). Note: Bronx Parkway is also known as Bronx River Parkway.
3. Shortly after getting on Bronx Pkwy North, the road will fork. Bear right (Bronx Parkway/White Plains) staying on Bronx Parkway.
4. Stay on Bronx Parkway for another 5.7 miles to Exit 15 (Fenimore Road).
5. Take left at stop sign. Go over highway and railroad tracks.
6. Take first left on Clubway (immediately before Mobil gas station).
7. Bear right into Scarsdale Golf Club. Park in lot on the left.

Note: If you drive more than 0.2 miles after getting off at Exit 15, you went too far.

Westchester or Connecticut (via Route 287)

1. Take Route 287 West to Exit 5 (Route 100). Take left at end of ramp.
2. Take left at first light onto Route 119 East/Route 100.
3. At fifth light (0.7 miles), take right onto Route 100 South (Central Avenue or Central Park Avenue).
4. Drive South on Central Avenue for 1.6 miles.
5. Take left on East Hartsdale Avenue (a major 4 way intersection).
6. Stay on East Hartsdale Avenue for 0.6 miles. After passing Mobil gas station on right, take first right on Clubway.
7. Bear right into Scarsdale Golf Club. Park in lot on the left.

Note: If you drive over railroad tracks and Bronx River Parkway, you went too far.

Westchester or Connecticut (via Hutchinson River Parkway)

1. Take Hutchinson River Parkway South to Exit 22 (Mamaroneck Road/Scarsdale/Mamaroneck). Do not confuse this with Exit 23 (Mamaroneck Avenue).
2. Take right onto Mamaroneck Road and stay on it for 2.6 miles until it ends at Route 22 (White Plains Post Road).
3. Take left at light onto White Plains Post Road.
4. Take immediate right at first light onto Fenimore Road.
5. Stay on Fenimore Road for 0.6 miles. Take left on Clubway (immediately before Mobil gas station).
Note: The turn for Clubway is 0.2 miles after going through a traffic light at the intersection of Fenimore Road and Fox Meadow Road.
6. Bear right into Scarsdale Golf Club. Park in lot on the left.

Note: If you drive into the Village of Hartsdale, you went too far.

Long Island

1. Take Whitestone Bridge to Hutchinson River Parkway North to Exit 13 (Cross County Parkway). Alternately, take Throgs Neck Bridge to Exit 10 (695 North/95 North/New Haven) to Exit 9 (Hutchinson River Parkway North) to Exit 13 (Cross County Parkway).
2. Take Cross County Parkway West to Exit 6 (Bronx Parkway). Bear right at first fork (Bronx Parkway North). Note: Bronx Parkway is also known as Bronx River Parkway.
3. Shortly after getting on Bronx Parkway North, the road will fork. Bear right (Bronx Parkway/White Plains) staying on Bronx Parkway.
4. Stay on Bronx Parkway for another 5.7 miles to Exit 15 (Fenimore Road).
5. Take left at stop sign. Go over highway and railroad tracks.
6. Take first left on Clubway (immediately before Mobil gas station).
7. Bear right into Scarsdale Golf Club. Park in lot on the left.

Note: If you drive more than 0.2 miles after getting off at Exit 15, you went too far.

New Jersey (via Tappan Zee Bridge)

1. Take Tappan Zee Bridge East to Exit 8 (White Plains/Rye/Route 287 East).
2. Take Route 287 East to Exit 5 (NY 100 South/Route 119 East).
3. At the traffic light at end of exit ramp, you will merge onto Route 119 East.
4. At third light (0.4 miles), take right onto Route 100 South (Central Avenue or Central Park Ave.)
5. Drive South on Central Avenue for 1.6 miles.
6. Take left on East Hartsdale Avenue (a major 4 way intersection).
7. Stay on East Hartsdale Avenue for 0.6 miles. After passing Mobil Gas Station on right, take first right on Clubway.
8. Bear right into Scarsdale Golf Club. Park in lot on left.

Note: If you drive over railroad tracks and Bronx River Parkway, you went too far.

New Jersey (via George Washington Bridge)

1. Take George Washington Bridge East to Major Deegan North. Follow directions from Manhattan #1.

Train from Grand Central Station

1. Take Harlem Line to Hartsdale.
2. Cross over railroad tracks. You want to be on the side with the train station waiting room.
3. As you face the Mobil Gas Station, Clubway is the first street to the left of the Mobil Station.
4. Walk up Clubway. Bear right into Scarsdale Golf Club.

Note: If you walk more than five minutes after getting off the train, you went too far.
